Senior Spa 1 Intro: 4 CE credit hr. Live Class

This class includes the topics covered in the 1 & 2 hr. Senior Spa Intro classes. Has your family or someone you know been affected by Alzheimer's? Working with dementia patients requires keen assessment and communication skills along with specialized techniques. Ayurveda is the 5,000 yr. old medical system that's still used in Asia. Ayurvedic practitioners treat you based on your body type, or 'dosha'. As a bonus, you'll take a quiz to discover yours.

Senior Spa 1 & 2 ~ 16 CE hr. Live Class



Senior Spa 1: 8 CE hrs.

Most therapists already have seniors in their families and as clients. Working with seniors requires specialized techniques and communication skills. Topics include: Basic principles of Ayurveda, 3 classes of seniors, 7 stages of Alzheimer's, special considerations for skin & joints, precautions/ contraindications, proper body mechanics, and massage on a senior in a wheelchair and prone on a massage table. Appropriate moist heat and aromatherapy applications are taught to open the minds and senses of this special population.

- Identify the 3 classes of seniors
- Identify the 3 Ayurvedic doshas
- Demonstrate the 3 stances of proper body mechanics

- Demonstrate massage technique on a senior in a wheelchair
- Demonstrate massage on a senior prone on a massage table

Senior Spa 2: 8 CE hrs.

Senior Spa 1 is a prerequisite.

Many seniors can't get on a massage table and those that do struggle to turn over. Special positioning techniques are taught that reduce fatigue in the senior client as well as the therapist. Also includes: moist heat, skin care services & aromatherapy applications for a senior in side lying and supine positions on a massage table or hospital bed either bare skinned or clothed. Instruction for proper completion of forms such as intake, SOAP notes, charting and standard medical abbreviations used within the healthcare setting. Provided are marketing materials and concepts for networking with senior communities, assisted living/memory care centers and active adult communities.

- Demonstrate massage techniques & skin care services on a senior client in supine & side lying positions
- Demonstrate massage techniques on a senior client in supine
 & side lying positions fully clothed
- Demonstrate proper techniques for applying moist heat & aromatherapy applications

- List documents to include in a marketing packet to present to senior communities
